HOLE DESCRIPTION





- **HOLE N°1** (Par 4: 410m)

Admire the different varieties of grass that breed in the waste bunker, a real pleasure for the eye. From the tee, lean to the right towards the driving range's flank and you shall have no trouble reaching the wide-open green in regulation.

- **HOLE N°2** (Par 3: 177m)

Pin positioning changes the levels of difficulty on this short Par 3. The reassuring presence of the green-side fairway, a bail out area, comforts those intimidated by the wild rough on the left side.

- **HOLE N°3** (Par 4: 327m)

It's birdie time on this short, dogleg right. The water hazard needs to be taken into account by the long hitters who will risk driving to the green under downwind conditions.

- **HOLE N°4** (Par 4: 344m)

A tee shot that can be managed without great difficulty except for the long bunker that stretches over the left side of the fairway. Access to the green is well guarded calling for a second shot that requires great precision.

- **HOLE N°5** (Par 4: 391m)

Admire the Atlas Mountains and take a minute to relax. You'll need it to achieve the driving distance that will enable you play this long Par 4 in regulation.

- **HOLE N°6** (Par 5: 463m)

This first Par 5 may appear simple... Yet, only those capable of driving long can attempt the birdie. Water is in play all along from the tee box down to the green. Strategy and precision are essential.

- **HOLE N°7** (Par 3: 220m)

A real test for distance, accuracy and control among highly skilled players. Numerous tees enable you to vary the distance and the angles of approach, leaving plenty of alternatives for less experienced players.

- **HOLE N°8** (Par 4: 417m)

A Par 4 for players who love the Driver. The double green of over 2 000m2 is a perfect setting to test your long putting skills.

- **HOLE N°9** (Par 5: 548m)

This long Par 5 has been rendered difficult by a left-side gully kept as a natural sanctuary and which will doubtlessly penalize a wandering ball. Watch out for the green's unsuspected slopes.

- **HOLE N°10** (Par 4: 376m)

The view from the island tee box facing the Atlas Mountains is spectacular. Be careful with the wadi that runs along this relatively short Par 4 and its well protected green.

- **HOLE N°11** (Par 5: 511m)

The landscaping on this Par 5 is beautifully balanced. A birdie is achievable as long as you avoid the trappings of the numerous, subtly positioned bunkers.

- **HOLE N°12** (Par 3: 117m)

A well-defended Par 3. On this double green, depending on flag positioning and your accuracy, you may find yourself playing unexpected shots.

- **HOLE N°13** (Par 4: 407m)

With as much waste bunker surface as fairway area, you will need to give it your best. Distance and skill are called upon on this scenic « signature » hole.

- **HOLE N°14** (Par 4: 314m)

Stretching along in the opposite direction of hole 13, the simplicity of this short Par 4 depends on the quality of your tee shot. A kind invitation to a birdie, a fleeting truce from the course's challenges...

- **HOLE N°15** (Par 4: 455m)

Two strong and accurate shots are necessary on this hole. The longest and most demanding of the course's Par 4's, a wayward or short drive will suggest laying-up on the second to avoid the punitive green side bunkers.

- HOLE N°16 (Par 5: 500m)

After a successful tee shot, long hitters may go for the green. No tricks on the green's approach and a good opportunity to score under par.

- **HOLE N°17** (Par 3: 189m)

To tame this challenging Par 3, be more water conscious than ever and lean to the left always. Sand save or chipping could be good score protecting options.

-HOLE N°18 (Par 4: 382m)

There are bunkers to avoid on each side of the fairway at drive's landing. The second shot overlooks the green and depending on the flag's position and the accuracy of your approach shot, water remains a threat. Last minute turnarounds may provide for a lively and dramatic finish.
