USEFUL INFORMATION FOR WEDDINGS

Required documents

To celebrate a wedding in Mauritius, the following documents are required by the Civil Status Office:

- 3 copies of the first three pages of the passports
- 3 copies of the birth certificates (Issued not more than 3 months before wedding date)
- 3 copies of the divorce certificate or certificate of death of spouse when applicable
- An application form (supplied by the T.O) duly filled in and signed by the future groom and bride
- French & Italian nationals should produce a "Certificat de Capacité de Mariage"

Conditions

- All wedding documents must be translated in English or French, all translations must be certified by the authorized translator
- A divorced bride-to-be, getting married within 10 months of the divorce must take a pregnancy test (at her own expense). Should the test be positive, the civil marriage cannot be celebrated in Mauritius
- All documents should be sent to the hotel at least 45 days prior to wedding date
- "Wedding" and "Honeymoon" packages include preferential tariffs throughout the stay and personalised gifts (choice of gift according to hotel's conditions)

Procedures in Mauritius

- Two foreigners wishing to get civilly married in Mauritius will no more require to produce any affidavit at the time of publication.
- In accordance with the Civil Status Act, civil status documents submitted should have been issued not more than 3 months of the date of the application for publication of the marriage

- However, where any party cannot produce any civil status document, he may instead produce an affidavit sworn in his country of residence or in such form as the Registrar of Civil Status may approve
- Two foreigners wishing to get civilly married in Mauritius and born in a non-common-wealth country will need to get their wedding certificate sent to the Prime Minister's Office for the apostille stamp in order for same to be recognised in their country of origin.
- At latest three working days before the wedding, clients have to go to the Registrar General Civil Status Office in Port-Louis.
- All original documents & affidavit will be checked by a civil status officer on the day of your legal formalities.
- Clients are requested to check accuracy of information given by registrar office on their personal details.

Costs (euros)

Other information

- No wedding during prime season
- Supreme Court and Civil Status do not operate on week-ends and public holidays
- Costs of taxi and legal services are subject to changes
- Government tax in Mauritius: 15%

USEFUL INFORMATION FOR RENEWALS OF VOWS

Required documents

- A proper wedding certificate will be asked

Conditions

- Clients willing to renew their vows in a Beachcomber hotel will have to book a "Renewal of Vows package"
- The "Renewal of Vows packages" are reserved for clients who are already officially married and who wish to renew their vows
- The "Renewal of Vows" package benefits from personalised gifts corresponding to

the gifts offered in the "Wedding" and "Honeymoon" packages (choice of gift according to hotel's conditions)

Other information

- Once clients have booked "Renewal of Vows package", they will have the ability to add "A la Carte" items
- A renewal of vows is not a "mock-up wedding"

Affidavits; Registration Fee; Return Transfer for civil status officer on wedding day; One way transfer to Prime Minister's Office (Port Louis) to drop wedding certificate for apostille; One way transfer to Prime Minister's office (Port Louis) to fetch wedding certificate with apostille; Two-way transfer to accompany guests to Port Louis to finalise all legal parts and formalities. A supplement will be applied to the package for customers who require an appointment at the respective embassy/consulate to leave their wedding certificates with apostille.
